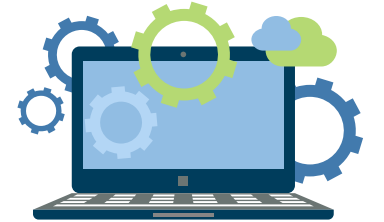

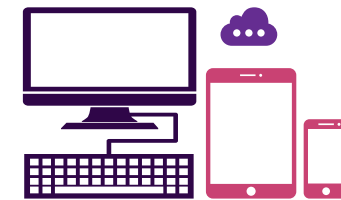

1. Children + Families



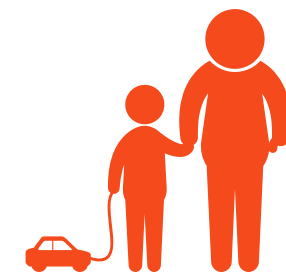

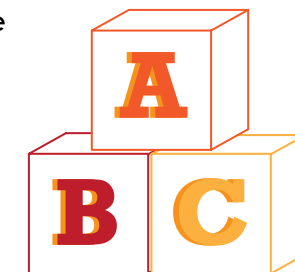
